## IMPROVEMENT TO FARMERS POTATOES AND GRASS

I tried SEER  
Rockdust on my  
**CARA POTATOES**  
on a *“with and  
without trial basis”*  
both this year and  
last year.



I applied it as a surface dressing both years just after planting to the same section of my field. Whilst in 2007 the difference was not so noticeable - when it came to harvesting this year the difference was very remarkable. There are **MORE POTATOES TO EACH PLANT** and the **INDIVIDUAL POTATOES ARE LARGER** where the **SEER Rockdust** had been applied. There is also an **IMPROVEMENT TO TASTE OF THE POTATOES** where the SEER Rockdust had been used.

In April this year I applied the remainder of the SEER Rockdust to the **GRASS PASTURE** for sheep in-front of my house. **This Summer the GRASS WAS GREENER, LONGER AND LUSHER** in the section of the field where the SEER Rockdust had been added.
