SEER ROCKDUST

I am writing with reference to my recent visit to the SEER Centre in June, when I purchased 4 bags of SEER Rockdust for my allotment and you kindly gave me some seeds of the purple flowering Broad Bean Grando Violette.

As I told you I had put some of the SEER Rockdust I bought last November onto my plot and the results have been marvellous, especially on the sweet corn and elephant garlic. I enclose 2 photos of my garlic lifted on the 16th July and 2 photos of my greens and beetroot looking good.

As you can see my neighbours plots on either side over the wire fence are looking pretty dismal compared to my plot that has benefited so much from the application of SEER Rockdust. If I get some sweet corn cobs I will let you have a photo for your records.

I planted the sherwood lettuce and the red one's you let me have and they are doing very well inspite of the very hot weather we have been having without any rain.

I hope to be back up to Loch Rannoch in November and I will call to make a visit then and purchase some more SEER Rockdust.

Looking forward to seeing you, regards to all.

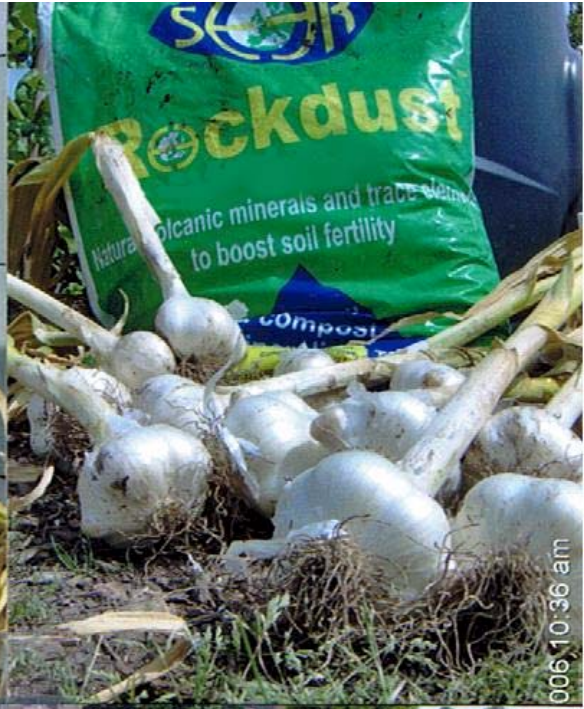
