## RESCUE FOR A VEGETABLE GARDEN

After moving here 12+ years ago, I was faced with a half-acre garden of steep, uncultivated bank.

To reduce the slope I had the soil from the foundations of the extension put on the lower bank.

This soil had NEVER been cultivated, but with loads of farmyard manure and double digging I was confident. After 2 - 3 years of poor crops I tested the soil, treating with lime and other minerals, followed by more "dung", then Growmore, still no success.

I remembered reading about SEER Rockdust so I bought some from the SEER Centre and got to work. **The results were spectacular - better than I'd ever achieved before.
